# 10 Days/ 9 Nights - Luxury Safari Adventure


Tarangire, Lake Manyara, Ngorongoro Crater, Olduvai Gorge, Serengeti National Park


## Day 1: Arusha arrival

Meet-and-greet at Kilimanjaro Airport and transfer to <u>Arusha Coffee Lodge</u>. Overnight stay in Arusha before departing for your safari the next day.

Day 2: Arusha to **Tarangire National Park** 







In the morning, we will pick you up from your hotel and drive to Tarangire National Park, which is known for its huge baobab trees and large herds of elephants. Its sparse vegetation makes it a beautiful and special location, where up to 300 elephants can be found, looking for underground streams in the dry riverbeds. Migratory wildebeest, zebra and buffalo can also be seen crowding the shrinking lagoons. You can also take part in walking safaris and night safaris, which are often not possible in national parks but are in Tarangire. Overnight stay at Tarangire Treetops.







Day 3: Tarangire to Lake Manyara







Today you will enjoy a day trip to Lake Manyara National Park, which is located within the Great Rift Valley. Lake Manyara boasts a spectacular setting, famous for its tree-climbing lions and soda-ash lake. The park also provides the perfect introduction to Tanzania's birdlife. The shores of the lake, encrusted with pink flamingo, attract more than 400 species of birds, many of them waterfowl or migrants. Overnight stay at Ngorongoro Serena Lodge.







**Day 4: Ngorongoro Crater** 


Today you'll rise early in the morning to descend the 600m high walls to the floor of Ngorongoro Crater and get up close with one of Africa's seven natural wonders! Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, it is considered one of the most beautiful and unique places in Africa. Here you will find a haven of African wildlife and you might also be lucky enough to witness the endangered Rhino! Enjoy a full day's game drive and a picnic lunch by the hippo pool. Overnight stay at Ngorongoro Serena Lodge.







Day 5: Serengeti National Park via Olduvai Gorge







Today you drive to one of the most famous game parks in Africa, the Serengeti! Known to host one of the most amazing wildlife spectacles on earth – the great migration of wildebeest and zebra – the Serengeti's vast plains are also home to a haven of other wildlife, including lions, cheetahs, leopards and many other predators. On the way to Serengeti, you will stop by Olduvai Gorge, one of the most important paleoanthropological sites in the world. Here you will witness the place occupied by the first human species 1.9 million years ago. Overnight stay in Serengeti Serena Lodge.







Day 6: Serengeti National Park (Central)

Now you have one full day to experience the vastness of the Serengeti plains and explore the centre of the park. With easy prey available throughout the year, there is plentiful big cat activity here and the dramatic rocky kopjes that dot the land serve as an excellent observation point for lions, leopards and cheetahs. Optional balloon ride can be included. Overnight stay in Serengeti Serena Lodge.







## Days to 7 to 8: The Serengeti (Northern)







This morning, you will board a light aircraft to the northern section of the Serengeti this morning, which is often touted as the most beautiful part of the park. If you plan your safari at the right time, you will be lucky enough to see two million wildebeest and zebra crossing the Mara River into Kenya. The herds plunge into the river by the thousands, and those that survive must stay alert enough to avoid the big cats lurking on the far side. Two overnight stays at Mara Mara Tented Lodge.

**Best time to visit:** Suitable all year-round. \*December to July to follow the wildebeest migration (either Ndutu or Mara River crossing). June to October to see predators.







Day 9: Fly from Serengeti to Arusha

This morning, you'll catch a glimpse of lions and other predators on their morning hunt during your first game drive. After brunch, you'll then leave the park and go for the final game drive before heading to the airstrip to take a flight to Arusha. Overnight stay in **Arusha Coffee Lodge.** 







### Day 10: Arusha to Kilimanjaro Airport

Today you will get the chance to explore more of Arusha or relax at your hotel before your flight back home. Transfer to Kilimanjaro Airport.

**Price does not include:** International flights; personal items (e.g. cameras, visa, travel insurance); alcoholic drinks; tips for your guide. Industry recommendations are \$20 USD a day to your guide divided by everyone in the vehicle.

**Suggestions on things to bring:** Extra binoculars, camera, sunglasses, hat and sunscreen, mosquito repellent, warm clothes for your early morning in Ngorongoro Crater, cool comfortable clothes for during the days.
